

ORDINANCE NO 95-03

ORDINANCE CONCERNING CITY PARK
REGULATION

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TURKEY, TEXAS
SECTION 1. PARK REGULATION

A. MOTORIZED VEHICLES PROHIBITED IN PARK

1. MOTORIZED VEHICLES, INCLUDING GO-CARTS, MOTOR CYCLES, MINIBIKES
AUTOMOBILES, PICKUP TRUCKS, FOUR WHEELERS, TRUCKS ARE HEREBY PROHIBITED
FROM DRIVING OR BEING DRIVEN IN THE PARK WITHIN THE BOUNDARY OF THE CITY OF
TURKEY PARK, AND EXCEPTING OFFICIAL PARK MAINTANCE VEHICLES AND POLICE
AND FIRE AND AMBULANCE VEHICLES ONLY.

B. FIREARMS PROHIBITED IN PARK

1. IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON TO HAVE IN HIS POSSESSION ANY
PISTOL, RIFLE, OR SHOTGUN, IN THE PARK WITHIN THE BOUNDARY OF THE CITY OF
TURKEY PARK, AND EXCEPTING LAW OFFICIAL ONLY.

PENALTIES

THE PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF ANY PART OR SECTIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE
SHALL BE A FINE OF NOT LESS THAT \$100.00 NOR MORE THAN \$500.00 PLUS COST TO
REPAIR PROPERTY OR FENCE. IN THE EVENT A VIOLATION OF MORE THAN ONE
SECTION OF THIS ORDINANCE IS COMMITTED BY A PERSON OR PERSONS IN THE SAME
TRANSACTION, EACH VIOLATION SHALL BE CONSIDERED A SEPERATE OFFENCE AND
PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF CONSTIUTES A DANGER TO THE
PUBLIC AND CREATES AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY, ACTING HEREIN BY ITS DULY CONSTITUTED AUTHORITIES, HERE BY WAIVES
THE THREE SEPARATE MEETINGS AND HEREBY DECLARES THE FOREGOING
ORDINANCE PASSED AND FINALLY EFFECTIVE AS OF THIS 15th DAY OF
March, 1995.

ORDINANCE No. 9503

ORDINANCE CONCERNING CITY PARK
REGULATION

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TURKEY, TEXAS

SECTION 1. PARK REGUALTION --- Upon finding a need for public safety, health or welfare, or preservation of park resources, the following ordinance is hereby enacted.

C. ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES PROHIBITED IN PARK

1. It is an offense to consume, or display an open container of an alcoholic beverage in the City Park or to sell alcoholic beverages within the City Park.

D. EXCESSIVE NOISE & LOUD MUSIC PROHIBITED IN PARK
BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 12:00 A.M. & 8:00 A.M.

1. It is an offense to conduct oneself in a manner in the City Park that disturbs other persons outside the immediate camp or site between the hours of 12:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m.
2. It is an offense to cause, create, or contribute to any noise which is broadcast, or caused to be broadcast in the City Park, into sleeping areas or houses, or which emits a sound beyond the person's immediate campsite or location, at any time between the hours of 12:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m., whether by shouting or singing, by using a radio, phonograph, television, or musical instrument, or by operating mechanical or electronic equipment.
 - (a) It is an offense to use electronic equipment, including electrical speakers, in the City Park, at a volume which emits sound beyond the immediate individual camp or site between the hours of 12:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m.
 - (b) It is an offense to create a disturbance by causing excessive noise, in the City Park, by any means between the hours of 12:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m.

E. DIGGING OF HOLES OR PITS PROHIBITED IN PARK

1. It is an offense to dig holes or pits of any size in the City Park for any reason, including but not limited to holes or pits for fires, trash, debris or waste.

F. OPEN FIRES PROHIBITED IN PARK
